PUBLIC APPOINTMENTS TO ADVISORY COMMITTEES

Stratford Public Library Board – Meets on the first Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. Operating under the Public Libraries Act, the Board is responsible for the governance of the public library. Its focus is on policy development, planning and advocacy. There are two (2) citizen representative positions available for interim 1-year terms concurrent with the term of Council. Trustees appointed for interim positions will be eligible to apply for the subsequent full term 2023-2026. To be eligible you must be a resident of Stratford. The SPL Board wishes to be representative of the entire community and is particularly interested in applications from people who can help bring new perspectives to the Board's decision-making process, including people aged 18-35, newcomers to Canada, and people with disabilities.

The deadline for receipt of applications is **Thursday September 9, 2021**.
