NOTICE OF COMMITTEE OF ADJUSTMENT HEARING

The Stratford Committee of Adjustment will consider the following applications at a hearing to be held on Wednesday, May 11, 2016 at 5:00 p.m. in the Avon Room, City Hall Annex, 82 Erie Street, Stratford:

MINOR VARIANCE APPLICATION—A09-16 – 223 CHURCH STREET

1990 is to allow the reconstruction of an accessory detached garage with the same setbacks as the existing detached garage.

Variances requested:

1. To permit an interior side yard setback to an accessory garage of 0.3m whereas 1.0m is required.
2. To permit an eaves to be located 0.1m from the side property line whereas 0.6m is required.

MINOR VARIANCE APPLICATION—A10-16 – 675 & 695 WRIGHT BLVD

Purpose: The purpose of this application under Section 44 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 is to reduce the exterior side yard setback for buildings, parking and parking aisles to accommodate a proposed industrial building.

Variances requested: To reduce the exterior side yard setback for parking spaces and parking aisles along Wright Blvd from 15m to 7.5m, to reduce the exterior side yard setback for buildings, parking spaces and parking aisles along Perth Line 29 from 15m to 7.5m, and to reduce the exterior side yard setback for buildings, parking spaces and parking aisles along Durkin Street from 7.5m to 2.0m.

If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent does not make written submissions to the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment before it gives or refuses to give a provisional consent, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss the appeal.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the City of Stratford Committee of Adjustment in respect of the proposed consent, you must make a written request to the Secretary-Treasurer, Stratford Committee of Adjustment, 82 Erie Street, 2nd Floor Stratford, ON N5A 2M4. This will also entitle you to be advised of a possible Ontario Municipal Board Hearing. Even if you are the successful party, you should request a copy of the decision since the Stratford Committee of Adjustment decision may be appealed to the Ontario Municipal Board by the applicant or another member of the public.

NOTICE – RAKING OF WINTER SAND

Reminder to residents from the Infrastructure & Development Services Department that during the months of April and May, winter sand that has accumulated can be raked to the edge of the road or the street gutter. Please help street sweeping operations by spreading the sand out in the gutter area. Please do not place the sand in large piles in the gutter or along the road, as the piles can restrict water flow and be a traffic hazard.
