NOTICE is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the City of Stratford

may be made by completing and filing in the office of the Clerk, nominations on the prescribed form and accompanied by the prescribed nomination filing fee of \$200.00 for the Head of Council and \$100.00 for all other offices. The filing fee is payable by cash, certified cheque, money order or debit.

Nomination packages are available from the Clerk's Office beginning May 1, 2018 during regular business hours.

A nomination must be signed by the candidate and may be filed in person or by an agent during regular business hours between May 1, 2018 and July 26, 2018 and between 9:00am and 2:00pm on July 27, 2018 (Nomination Day). Candidates for Mayor and Councillor are required to include endorsement signatures from 25 eligible voters in the 2018 Stratford election. Candidates are encouraged to obtain more than 25 endorsement signatures. Nomination packages are available in the Clerk's office.

In the event there are an insufficient number of certified candidates to fill all positions available, nominations will be reopened for the vacant positions only, on Wednesday, August 1, 2018, between the hours of 9:00am and 2:00pm and such additional nominations, if required, may be filed in the office of the Clerk.

Electors are hereby given notice that if a greater number of candidates are certified than are required to fill the said offices, voting places will be opened on the dates stated below for the purpose of voting in Stratford.

VOTING PERIOD – Friday, October 12, 2018 at 10:00am to Monday, October 22, 2018 at 8:00pm.

### **NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THIRD PARTY ADVERTISERS**

#### **Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (s.88)**

NOTICE is hereby given that individuals, trade unions or corporation interested in conducting third party advertising during the 2018 municipal election in Stratford are required to register with the Clerk to be a third party advertiser. Being registered with the municipality allows the third party to advertise to the voters in Stratford.

Third Party Advertising refers to advertisements or other materials that support, promote or oppose a candidate running for council or school trustee. A candidate running for any municipal council or school board trustee cannot register to be a third party advertiser.

To register as a third party advertiser, obtain a Registration Package including Registration (Form 7) from the Clerk's Office at City Hall beginning May 1, 2018. There is no filing fee to register as a third party advertiser.

A Registration (Form 7) must be signed by the third party advertiser and filed in person between May 1 and October 19, 2018 during regular business hours.

It is important to understand the responsibilities as a potential third party advertiser. Please review the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 for more information.

## **NOTICE: NEW LAWS FOR BROADCASTERS AND PUBLISHERS ON THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING DURING THE 2018 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

On April 1, 2018, the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 (s.88.3-88.7), introduced amendments to regulate third party advertising. These regulations are now in effect to manage third party advertising during the 2018 municipal election. Voting during the municipal election in the City of Stratford will take place between Friday October 12 and Monday, October 22, 2018.

It is important to understand the responsibilities as a broadcaster or publisher of third party advertising. Please review the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 for more information.

Legal Obligations for Broadcasters and Publishers in the Municipal Election

The new requirements for broadcasters and publishers include:

### **1. Mandatory Information**

A registered third party advertiser must provide the following information to the broadcaster or publisher in writing before the third party advertisement appears:

- Name of the registered third party
- Name of the business address and telephone number of the individual who deals with the broadcaster or publisher under the direction of the registered third party
- Municipality where the registered third party is registered

### **2. Maintaining Records**

The broadcaster or publisher of a third party advertisement must maintain records for 4 years after the date the advertisement appears. These records must contain:

- Mandatory information described in section 1 (above), as outlined under section 88.5(2) of the Act
- A copy of the advertisement, or the means of reproducing it for inspection
- A statement of charge made for its appearance.

The public must be permitted to inspect the records during normal business hours.

### **3. Charges and Contributions**

The broadcaster or publisher may not charge a third party advertiser more or less than their normal advertising rate. If less is charged, the difference is deemed to be a contribution to the third party advertiser. Providing free advertising is considered a contribution towards the third party advertiser, unless all third party advertisers are offered the same service.

### **4. Broadcasters or Publishers as Registered Third Party Advertisers**

Broadcasters or publishers, who wish to conduct third party advertising, must register as a third party advertiser and follow the Act's requirements. A Third Party Advertisers' guide, published by the Government of Ontario, is included in the Registration Package available from the Clerk's Office at City Hall.

### **5. Restricted Campaign Period**

Broadcasters and publishers may only permit third party advertisements to appear between May 1, 2018 and October 22, 2018 (Election Day), once the third party has registered with the City Clerk.

## **FLUSHING OF FIRE HYDRANTS**

Beginning April 8, 2018, and continuing for approximately six weeks, flushing of fire hydrants will take place within the City of Stratford. Customers could experience some discoloured water. Water quality is not affected by this colouration. Discoloured water will clear, but before doing laundry, please check to see that water has cleared. ## **NOTICE - RAKING OF WINTER SAND**

Reminder to residents from Infrastructure & Development Services that during the months of April and May, winter sand that has accumulated can be raked to the edge of the road or the street gutter. Please help street sweeping operations by spreading the sand out in the gutter area. Please do not place the sand in large piles in the gutter or along the road, as the piles can restrict water flow and be a traffic hazard.
