NOTICE OF INTENT TO DECLARE SURPLUS AND TO DISPOSE OF SURPLUS LAND - PART OF DURKIN STREET, NOW CLOSED

Notice is given pursuant to the Sale and Other Disposition of Land Policy P.3.1, that City Council intends to declare a part of the Durkin Street road allowance now closed, to be surplus to the needs of the City of Stratford and to dispose of the subject property.

The part of Durkin Street permanently closed is situated north of Wright Boulevard in the Wright Business Park and is no longer required by the City.

At the April 24, 2017 Council meeting, Council adopted a by-law to permanently close this part of Durkin Street. Council now intends to consider declaring this part of Durkin Street now closed, to be surplus to the needs of the City and to authorize the disposal. NOTICE - RAKING OF WINTER SAND

Reminder to residents from Infrastructure & Development Services that during the months of April and May, winter sand that has accumulated can be raked to the edge of the road or the street gutter.
