PUBLIC NOTICE

Outdoor Fire Ban – City of Stratford

In effect immediately, as of July 9, 2018, all open air fires that require a burn permit, as defined in By-law 5-2006, are prohibited anywhere in the City of Stratford. This does not include backyard recreational fire pits.

This fire ban is being imposed due to the extreme dryness of all vegetation in the City of Stratford. Provincial forest and wild-land fire indicators are all at extreme levels. This ban shall remain in effect until further notice.

Farmers operating within the city limits are encouraged to exercise extreme caution with combining, as field fires can quickly overtake equipment, neighbouring crops; and these fires can spread quickly into adjacent woodlands.

If you discover a fire in the open, it is very important that you report fires immediately to 9-1-1. Do not delay reporting while attempting to extinguish the fire.

All burning permits in the City of Stratford are now suspended. No burning permits will be issued until the ban is lifted.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE TRAFFIC AND PARKING BY-LAW 159-2008

s. 8(1)o Do not park opposite a driveway where the road is less than 28 feet in width.

This section is intended to allow residents the safe entrance and exit from their driveways on narrow streets. Heavily enforced areas are Brunswick St, Cobourg St and Rebecca St.

s. 10 No Parking in a "No Parking" area/space.

This section also applies to individuals with an accessible parking permit.

s. 49(4) No parking at a meter with a hood.

Meter hoods indicate a spot that been designated as no parking, unless you are the renter of the hood.

s. 16 No parking/standing or stopping in an (un)loading zone/space.

It must be clear that you are in the process of (un)loading your vehicle and must be a reasonable length of time.
