## CITY OF STRATFORD – NOTICE OF CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT ADDENDUM COMPLETION

### For the Storm Sewer Improvements/Realignment & Queen Street Diversion (Schedule 'B' Undertaking)

In July 2017, the City of Stratford has completed an Addendum to the Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for the sewer improvements/realignment, Queen Street Diversion. This Class EA Addendum has been carried out in accordance with the Municipal Class Assessment planning process. The preferred alternative in the 2004 South Side Storm System Class Environmental Assessment study was sewer improvements/realignment and Queen St. Diversion and PDC isolation for the Collegiate Arch outlet system. This Addendum provides the design and construction methods for the Queen Street Sewer diversion undertaking.

If concerns arise regarding the Class EA Addendum that cannot be resolved through discussions with the City of Stratford, a person/party may request that the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a "Part II Order"). The request must be received by the Minister by August 25, 2017, with a copy sent to the Director, Environmental Approvals Branch, City Clerk and the City's Project Manager at the addresses indicated below. If there are no Part II Order requests received by this date, the City of Stratford may proceed with construction of the project.
