Bring in your Hazardous waste to the City of Stratford Landfill site located at 777 Romeo St. South. Materials will be accepted at the landfill Friday July 29th 8:00am – 5:00pm and Saturday July 30th, 8:00 am - 12:00 pm.

LEAF AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION WILL ONLY BE COLLECTED IN THE FOLLOWING FORMS:

- 110 L Kraft Paper bags
- Certified Compostable bags
- Re-useable Container with label attached

Clear Plastic Bags are **NOT** accepted and will be left at the curbside.

Leaf and Yard waste is accepted at the landfill depot during regular landfill hours.
