PARKING INFORMATION

The hourly parking meter rate has changed to **\$1.00 per hour** at all parking meters and pay & display machines in the downtown core and in municipal parking lots. All meters have been changed over to the new rate.

Parking meters in the downtown core are 3 hour meters, unless posted otherwise. However, the meters around the outside of the downtown core are 12 hour meters. **Payment is required Monday to Saturday 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. Payment is required at all accessible spots.**

Please note that parking spots in the Cooper and Downie Street lots continue to remain free for a maximum of 72 hours.

NOTICE OF BY-LAW TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE DOVER STREET, PLAN 47

Notice is given pursuant to the *Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, chapter 25* as amended and Notice Policy C.3.1 that City Council intends to pass a by-law to permanently close a portion of the Dover Street road allowance.

The Dover Street road allowance is shown on Plan 47 and is located east of King Street and west of Romeo Street South. A former part of the Dover Street road allowance was previously closed by By-law 24-81. The intent is to now close and dispose of the remainder of the Dover Street road allowance.

A Public Meeting was held on July 27, 2015 to hear from the public regarding the proposed closure of the remainder of the Dover Street road allowance.

Pursuant to Sale and Other Disposition of Land Policy P.3.1 as amended, Notice of Intent to Declare Surplus and Dispose was given on January 30, 2016. Council then declared the remainder of the Dover Street road allowance to be surplus to the needs of The Corporation of the City of Stratford at its meeting held on February 8, 2016 with the intent to dispose of the surplus road allowance.
