NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Stratford Council will hear the following application at a Public meeting to be held on Monday, July 25 2016 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers in City Hall, 1 Wellington Street, Stratford to hear all interested persons with respect to the zone change application under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990.

ZONE CHANGE – Z01-16 for 173 Huron Street

The application affects the property with the municipal address of 173 Huron Street, located on the south side of Huron Street, between John Street N and St. Vincent Street N., legally described as PLAN 20 W PT LOT 74. The property has a frontage of 12.68m on Huron Street and an area of 522 m².

The property is zoned Mixed Use Residential Zone (MUR) which permits a range of residential uses, day nursery, hostel, inn, nursing home, religious institution, retirement home, specialized medical offices. The zone also allows business or professional office, commercial school, personal care establishment, private school and studio if they operate within an existing dwelling that contains at least one dwelling unit. The applicant is proposing to rezone the property to a Residential Third Density R3 Zone – special to reduce the minimum lot frontage for a quadruplex to 12.68m to reduce the minimum lot area for a quadruplex to 522 m² and to reduce the minimum landscaped open space to 26.9%. The special regulations will allow for the proposed quadruplex development.

If a person or public body does not make oral submission at a public meeting or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Stratford to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the By-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
