## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING FOR APRIL 25, 2016**

Official Plan Amendment O01-16, City of Stratford, 24 Glastonbury Drive, (Former fairground lands)

City of Stratford Council will hold a public meeting on **Monday April 25, 2016 at 7:05 p.m.** in the Auditorium in City Hall, 1 Wellington Street, Stratford to hear all interested persons with respect to the Official Plan Review (File O01-16) under Section 21 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990. This is a City of Stratford initiated review of the Official Plan policies related to the property located on the north side of Britannia Street west of Glastonbury Drive, municipally known as the "old fairgrounds lands", having a municipal address of 24 Glastonbury Drive and legally described as Part Lot 3, Concession 1, Township of Ellice, (now in the City of Stratford). The property has approximately 170 m (557 ft.) of frontage on Britannia Street and an area of 11.5 ha (28.5 ac).

The City has declared a portion of the lands surplus and is considering special policies in the Official Plan to provide greater certainty for future development. In addition to the Residential Area policies contained in the existing Official Plan and the Residential Area policies contained in the adopted but not yet in effect Official Plan Update (Official Plan Amendment No. 21), the City is undertaking a Review with the intent of applying area specific policies which include the following:

- requiring a minimum net density of residential dwellings of 25 unit per hectare (10 units per acre);
- requiring the form, massing and appearance of future buildings to be consistent with the character of adjacent buildings and,
- requiring future development to provide public road access to the City of Stratford Rotary Complex.

Your opinion on this application is important. Please call, mail, email, or fax your comments to the City of Stratford, Development Services Division by **Tuesday, April 5, 2016** in order for your comments to be incorporated in the Planning Report.

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan Amendment, or of the refusal of a request to amend the Official Plan, you must make a written request to the City of Stratford.

If a person or public body does not make oral submission at a public meeting or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Stratford to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds add the person or public body as a party.
