NOTICE OF PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE ON BED AND BREAKFAST ESTABLISHMENTS AND SHORT TERM RENTAL ACCOMMODATIONS

In April 2015, the City of Stratford retained MMM Group Limited, a WSP Company, to assist in the preparation of a new Comprehensive Zoning By-law and much of the feedback to date has focused on Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Short Term Rental Accommodations. As a result, the City is holding a public open house specifically to review existing By-laws as they relate to Accessory Guest Suites/Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Short Term Rental Accommodations regulations and how these uses should be regulated, addressed in the future on **Monday, May 15, 2017 at 7:00 pm** at the **Stratford Rotary Complex** in the **Tim Taylor Lounge** (2nd floor). We invite you to participate in this important event to provide your input in **Shaping Stratford**.

What is a Zoning By-law? The Zoning By-law is the City's primary tool to regulate the use of all land in the City, it establishes what uses are permitted and what criteria a use must meet for it to be permitted. The New Comprehensive Zoning By-law will implement the policies of the City's new Official Plan and provide updated zoning and development standards that reflect new policy and regulatory initiatives at the provincial and City level.

Licensing By-law: The City currently regulates Bed and Breakfast Establishments, Accessory Guest Rooms and Guest through Licensing By-law (By-law 180-2004). The aforementioned uses are required to be licensed.

Scope of Options: A broad range of options will be presented which will include the following:

- Maintaining the current regulations (status quo);
- Enacting minimal zoning and licensing regulations to deal with health and safety issues only,
- Enacting comprehensive zoning and licensing regulations to deal with a number of issues including but not limited to: health and safety issues, ownership, location, parking, maximum number of licenses issued, length of occupancy, and form of building; and
- Permitting Accessory Guest Suites/Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Short Term Rental Accommodations as-of-right.

The Event: This Public Open House provides you an important opportunity to comment on possible future zoning and licensing by-law provisions as they related to Bed and Breakfast Establishments and Short Term Rental Accommodations. **We encourage all members of the public to attend this important Public Open House and provide your input.**

A short presentation will be given which will be followed by a Q&A session from the audience.

Opportunities for Input: At key points throughout the Comprehensive Zoning By-law Update, the project team has engaged the public. There will be a number of opportunities – both on-line and in-person – for you to provide your input. NOTICE - RAKING OF WINTER SAND

Reminder to residents from Infrastructure & Development Services that during the months of April and May, winter sand that has accumulated can be raked to the edge of the road or the street gutter. NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS - DESTROY NOXIOUS WEEDS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all property owners in accordance with the WEED CONTROL ACT OF ONTARIO, that unless noxious weeds growing on their lands within the Municipality of Stratford are destroyed by June 1, 2017 and throughout the season, the Municipality may enter upon said lands and cause the noxious weed or weed seeds to be destroyed, charging the costs against the land in taxes as set out in the Act.

In the interest of public health, the noxious weeds requiring eradication include Giant Hogweed, Ragweed and Poison Ivy. Other noxious weeds requiring eradication include European Buckthorn, Thistles, Jointed Goatgrass, and others as designated under the above Act.
