NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING – ZONE CHANGE APPLICATION Z05-17

The City of Stratford Council will hear the following applications at a public meeting to be held on Monday December 11, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers in City Hall, 1 Wellington Street, Stratford to hear all interested persons with respect to the zone change application under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990. The application affects the property on the North side of Britannia Street between Glastonbury Drive and Briarhill Drive, with a frontage of 82m, a depth of 94m and an area of 1 ha (2.4 ac).

Purpose: The purpose of this application under Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990 is to change the zoning on the subject lands FROM Institutional/ Future Residential- Special—IN/FR-1 zone that permits a trailer camp and all other uses permitted in the institutional zone TO a Residential Fifth Density -R5(1) Special zone that permits an apartment dwelling, nursing home, seniors' apartment dwelling and retirement home/ lodge. Special provisions have been requested to allow the lot line along Britannia Street to be defined as the front lot line, to reduce the interior side yard to 3m, to reduce the exterior side yard setback on the west side to 3m, to reduce the parking rate to 1.25 spaces per dwelling unit, and to reduce the sight triangle on the southwest corner to 9.9m by 9.9m for an apartment dwelling.

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Zoning Amendment or of the refusal of a request to amend the Zoning By-law, you must make a written request to the City of Stratford.

If a person or public body does not make oral submission at a public meeting or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the City of Stratford to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submission to the City of Stratford before the By-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

MEETING NOTICE: ANIMAL CONTROL WORKING GROUP

The City of Stratford's Animal Control Working Group (ACWG) will be holding a meeting on Tuesday 21 November at 4:30pm. The meeting will be held in the Falstaff Room, located on the 2nd floor of 82 Erie Street, Stratford. This meeting is open to the public.

The Animal Control Working Group was appointed to help the City in its review of Animal Control Bylaw 195-2002. The ACWG is comprised of nine (9) members who provide a balance of perspectives on the issues identified for this bylaw review. Issues subject to review have been identified as follows:

- Banning the sale of pets in pet stores;
- Limiting the number of pets allowed per household;
- Updating licensing requirements;
- Limiting the amount of dogs per owner allowed in the off-leash Stratford Dog Park;
- Revisions and/or updates to definitions in the bylaw;
- Updates to the standards of animal care requirements;
- Leashing of cats;
- Allowing chickens as pets;
- Enforcement issues.

Note: Other issues may arise as a result of Committee discussions.

The ACWG provides a forum for consultation, review and exchange of information regarding the City's Animal Control Bylaw/relevant sections of the Business Licensing Bylaw.
