NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A BY-LAW TO PERMANENTLY CLOSE PART OF GRIFFITH ROAD WEST DESCRIBED AS PARTS 33 AND 34 ON 44R-2535

Notice is given pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, chapter 25 as amended and Notice Policy C.3.1 that City Council intends to pass a by-law to permanently close a portion of the Griffith Road West road allowance. The portion of Griffith Road West to be permanently closed is described as Parts 33 and 34 on 44R-2535 and approximately 462 m² or 4,973 sq. ft. in size.

Parts 33 and 34 on 44R-2535 form part of a turn-around bulb at the westerly limit of Griffith Road West. This portion of the turn-around bulb is no longer required by the City.

City Council shall hear from any person wishing to be heard regarding the intent to adopt a by-law to permanently close Parts 33 and 34 on 44R-2535. The date, time and location of the Council meeting where Council shall hear from any persons regarding the proposed road closure is:
